RFCs – THE ROLE OF REGULATORY BODIES

Regulation 913/2010 defined RBs' functions:

- ⇒ monitoring of competition in rail freight corridors
- ⇒ ensuring non-discriminatory access to corridors
- ⇒ acting as appeal bodies

however:

- ⇒ no formal data collection powers

As IRG-Rail we declare to continue and strengthen our cooperation:

- IRG-Rail developed Guidelines on Cooperation between National RBs in RFCs
- IRG-Rail Members signed 8 RFCs cooperation agreements

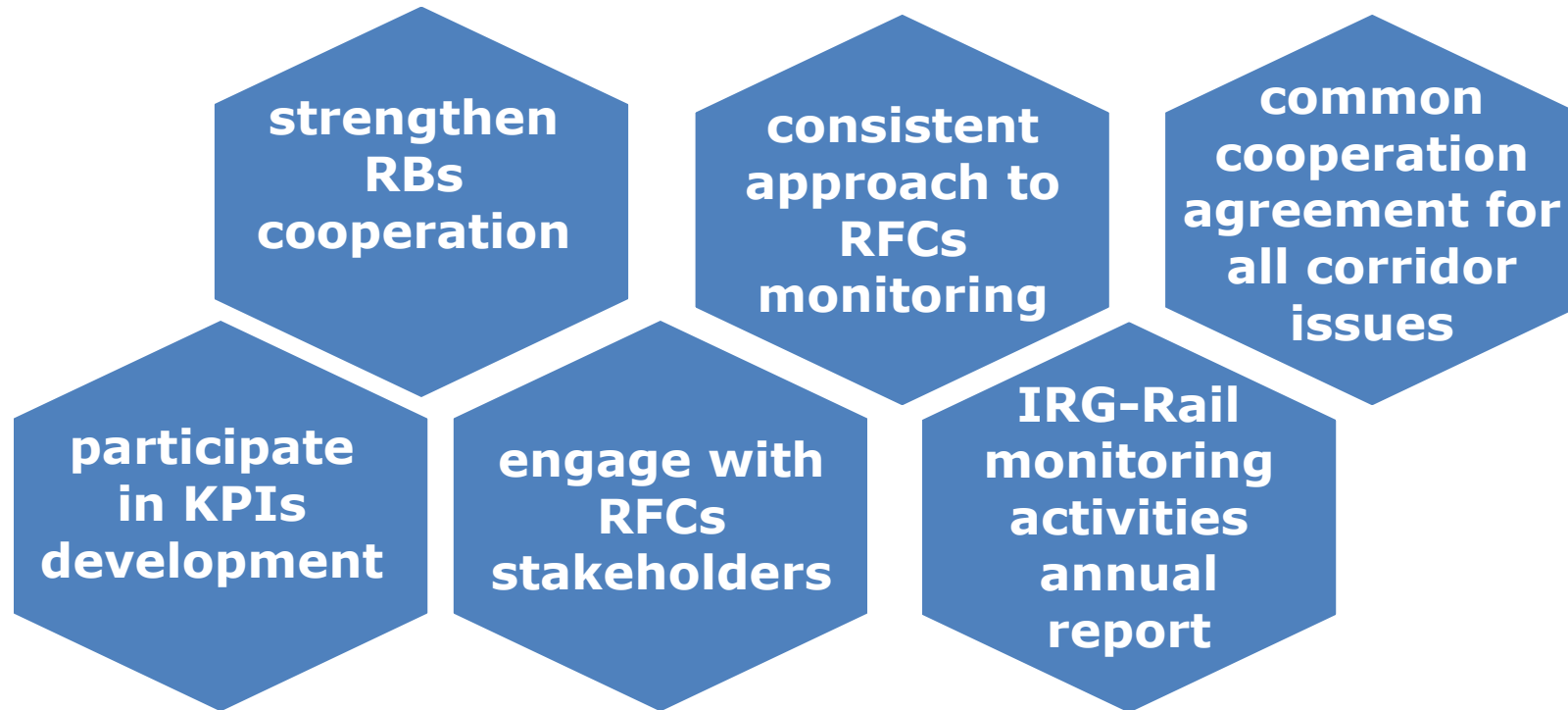
